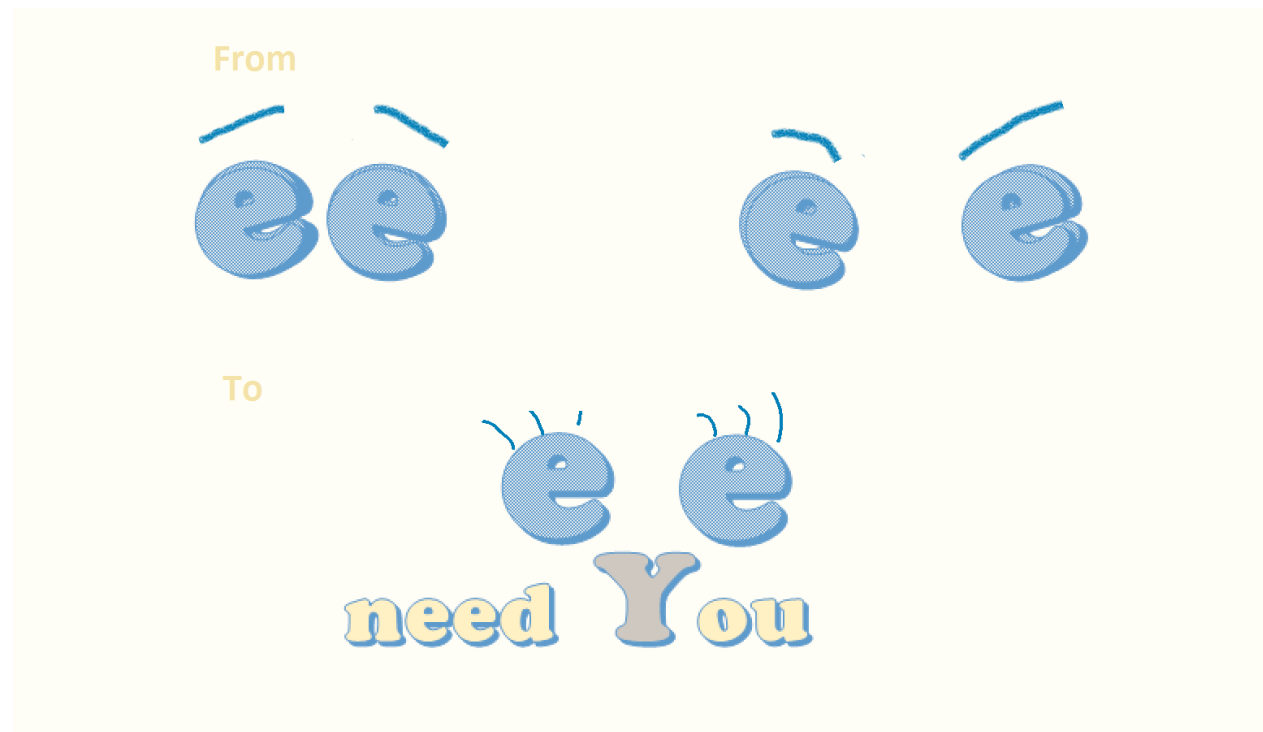

## Would the research project be a good fit for me?

The study might be a good fit for you if:

- Over eighteen years of age
- Have good and equal vision in both eyes when wearing corrective eyewear
- No history of eye surgery, lazy eye or turned eye.

## What would happen if I took part in the research project?

You will be required to complete one assigned vision therapy procedure for 15 minutes a day, four days a week for three weeks at the School of Optometry and Vision Science

Two eye exam on your visual skills one before and one after the vision therapy program, each will take half an hour.

## Will I be paid to take part in the research project?

There are no additional costs associated with participation in this research project. A ten dollar gift voucher will be given at the completion of the study as a gesture of appreciation at the conclusion of the study.
