* It is expected that students have an Occluder/Pinhole, PD/Pupil gauge, and Pentorch from stage 2 – these will be used in OPTM6400 (Stage 4, Term 1). They can also be purchased online.

** The items in this column will be needed by Week 1 of Term 2, for Clinic. They may need to be imported, so the purchases must be made well in advance.

All of these items in this column must be purchased through the manufacturers/importers because they require TGA approval. A Manufacturer's Day has been arranged, when manufacturers will be available, with samples of the instruments, at the Roundhouse at UNSW. Manufacturer's day is Friday Nov 22 from 9 am to 2 pm. Stage 3 students should attend the Manufacturer's Day, ask questions, and soon after that, decide on preferred purchases. The Manufacturers will know /announce the deadlines for purchase or making a deposit.

Some students won't know whether they will need this equipment until offers are made in early January. These students should attend the Manufacturer's Day, decide on the preferred equipment, and be ready to place the final order soon after receiving an offer.

***The preclinical lab and the clinic have gonio lenses for you to use, so you may delay the purchase of the gonio lens until you are in practice if you wish.
