

Can Nutrition be Linked to Glaucoma?

Researchers at UNSW Kensington (The University of New South Wales) are seeking volunteer research participants to learn about whether there is a link between diet, supplementation and sunlight exposure in relation to glaucoma.

Would the research study be a good fit for me?

The study might be a good fit for you if you are:

- Are 40 years or older;
- Have had an eye test by an optometrist or ophthalmologist in the past 36 months
- Have NOT been diagnosed with any type of glaucoma in one or both eyes

What would happen if I took part in the research study?

If you decide to take part in the research study, we will ask you to complete an online questionnaire. The questionnaire will ask you questions about your diet and supplement intake over the past week and level of sunlight exposure. It should take approximately 10-15 minutes to complete.

Will I be paid to take part in the research study?

There are no additional costs associated with participation in this research study, nor will you be paid.
